This will also cover continuous professional development and support for staff.	The use of technology will be integrated into the daily life of a child's leaning. To employ an additional 0.5 teacher to support children in year 6 that have been identified at risk of falling behind.	Most children in year six would be of national average by the end of the academic year.	Children would be secondary school ready. What is the overall impact of the spending?
<p>The children in year 6 were more ready than if we didn't have a teacher. Impact was difficult to track as there was another lockdown for the spring term where we taught remotely for four hours a day.</p> <p>Assessment shows that the children did make progress but rapid progress was hampered due to the spring lock down.</p> <p>Ipads meant that children could share work with the teacher and class without leaving their seat or moving between bubbles.</p>
How will the changes be communicated to parents and stakeholders?
<p>End of year reports were published for parents to see the progress the children had achieved.</p>
